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## CHARDONNAY

A favourite the world over; the Chardonnay grape is originally from the east of France. It is the white grape grown in Burgundy and Champagne. Bordeaux-style blends include combinations of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Malbec and Petit Verdot. Rhone style blends are a combination of Shiraz, Grenache and Mourvèdre. Cape Blends have Pinotage as one of the blending partners. Although these wines vary widely in style and complexity; they will none the less pair well with hearty and meaty dishes.

## CABERNET SAUVIGNON

A noble red cultivar; it can stand alone triumphantly or be blended with Merlot, Cabernet Franc and others in the Bordeaux Style. Typically robust and often aged for up to 10 years without loss of structure. An excellent accompaniment to red meat and venison.

## PINOT NOIR

Burgundy's best. The grape that makes the red Bourgogne what it is, Pinot Noir's small grapes are notoriously difficult to grow and don't like much heat. Those who have perfected the art in South Africa are producing world class wines in cooler parts of the Cape. Most suited to duck and lamb, also fillet steak; savour the art.

## PINOTAGE

South Africa's own, grafted from Burgundy classic pinot and the local hermitage by Professor Perold of Stellenbosch in the 1920's, this varietal is growing in stature and is now grown as far afield as New Zealand. Its lighter style, makes it extremely versatile as a companion to red meat, game and chicken.

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## SHIRAZ

Also known as Syrah outside of South Africa and Australia, particularly in France's Northern Rhone Valley, it is well suited to South Africa's warmer wine-growing climate and is increasing in popularity, renown and hence acreage. It's spicy and sometimes smoky tones go well with red meat and venison.
